Hello Andrada Families,

Last week you received a letter from Superintendent Carruth about hybrid instruction in Vail. Assuming the metrics continue to improve, Vail will move into the Hybrid Phase beginning Monday, September 21<sup>st</sup>. The purpose of the hybrid phase is to welcome students back onto campus while still social distancing and limiting exposure.

*Students who are currently enrolled in on-line classes through the VIC will continue these classes until the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester. For all other students, parents have two options:*

- 1.) **Hybrid:** In-person 2 days and remote/asynchronous instruction 3 days
- 2.) **Brick to Click:** Remote/asynchronous instruction through APHS all 5 days (similar to current Remote Instruction model)

These two choices look different at each high school. Below are the details for both Hybrid and Brick to Click at Andrada High School.

### **GROUPING**

#### **HYBRID STUDENTS**

- The **BLUE** Group—students with last names beginning A-K
- The **SILVER** Group—students with last names beginning L-Z

#### **BRICK TO CLICK STUDENTS**

- The **MAV** Group—All Brick to Click students

\*\*\*Students living in the same household with different last names, can be in the same group upon request by calling the front office at 879-3302. Other exceptions will not be made.

### **HYBRID STUDENTS**

- The **BLUE** Group will attend school in-person on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- The **SILVER** Group will attend school in-person on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- On days when each hybrid group is not at school, they will be working on asynchronous lessons relating to the previous in-person lesson or preparing them for the next in-person lesson.

**BRICK TO CLICK STUDENTS**

- The MAV Group (all Brick to Click students) will “live stream” each class on Tuesdays and Thursdays and participate in the in-person lesson taking place.
- On Mondays and Wednesdays, the MAV Group will work on asynchronous lessons relating to the previous “live streamed” lesson or preparing them for the next “live streamed” lesson.
- The MAV Group is following the SILVER Group’s instruction schedule.

**FRIDAYS**

- No in-person instruction
- Asynchronous work may be assigned
- Reteach and targeted tutoring will be available
- Office hours for teachers and counselors

**BELL SCHEDULE (HYBRID PHASE)**

- Zero hour is 7:40-8:40 Monday through Thursday.
- Two lunches will reduce the number of students in the commons and allow for safer social distancing.
- Students' lunch will be determined by their 4<sup>th</sup> period class. This information will be emailed the week before hybrid instruction begins.
- Students may not be dropped off prior to 8:30 am (excluding zero hour students) and must be picked up by 4:15 pm. There will be no after school activities.

- At the same time, you will receive information regarding home health checks, the Health and Wellness Guide for Students, and your students lunch assignment based on 4<sup>th</sup> period teacher.
